DESCRIPTION: Create an artful unlined topper that falls on the bias flattering all figure types. Most everyone will leave with their topper complete all but the hem.

SKILL LEVEL: Beginner___ Confident Beginner_X_ Intermediate___ Advanced___

PREREQUISITE (If any): Be sure you know how to thread (3-thread) and adjust your tensions on your serger.

SUPPLIES REQUIRED: (Be sure to purchase early)

- Fabric: This is an easy flowing top so the inside needs to look as good as the outside, for example, a hand dyed silk. You can choose either crepe de chine, chiffon/georgette, rayon or any other light-weight drape-y type fabric.
- All fabric should be pre-washed if you intend on hand washing after construction.
- Fabric requirement is based on 44" wide fabric.
- All sizes through extra large require 2 yards.
- 3 spools of serger thread to match fashion fabric
- Basic serger supplies - whatever you normally need for a day of sewing with your serger
- Pen and paper for notes (handout will be included for pattern)

SERGER: Yes _X_ Don't forget your tweezers to assist with threading!

Basic Sewing Supplies: Yes-X_ No___ This includes: Good quality fabric scissors, small scissors or thread nips, straight pins, 6" seam gauge or ruler, seam ripper, fabric marker, assorted machine needles, pen and paper for notes, any other items you commonly use. Please call us with questions.

Machine Requirements: Your machine and embroidery unit should be in good working order. Please come with knowledge of operations suitable for the class content.
