CLASS DESCRIPTION: Is it crocheted? Is it knitted? Is it lace? The answer is no to each of those questions because it is "crazy felt." The look is completely controlled by your choice of yarns and how densely you choose to construct your top. This is a fun project that can take on many dimensions and is limited only by your imagination! In class you will construct the entire garment, but the joy and element of surprise will come after you launder and air-dry it!

PREREQUISITE (If any): Love of creativity and play!

SUPPLIES REQUIRED: (Be sure to purchase early)

- 1 skein of yarn that is at least 50% mohair wool - any color
- 1 skein of yarn that is a different texture but contains at least 20% wool
- 3-5 different specialty effect yarns (20-30 yards each or totaling approx. 120 yards. The specialty yarns are for contrast, texture, and fringe
- OPTIONAL-microfiber yarn (fluffy yarn) – one of the specialty yarns – if you want your top to have a denser feel and look. This will add a bit of bulk to the finished top.
- Bits of tulle, lace, trims, ribbons and small pieces of fabric ( 1"x1") can also be added for texture
- Water Soluble Stabilizer (Economy Size – 19 ½ x 3 yards) – medium or light weight
- Universal Sharp needles (#80)
- Isacord thread (color of choice for both bobbin and top stitching)
- Glass head pins
- Spay adhesive (505)
- OPTIONAL: Sew Slip multi- purpose sheet
- OPTIONAL: Crazy Felt by Jeannette Knake Search Press
- OPTIONAL: Wool roving if you wish to felt a flower for trim
