DESCRIPTION: Learn bobbin work embroidery - experiment with different decorative threads and decorative stitches to see the different effects you can create. At the end of class we will use those new talents to make a wonderful and unique bookmark.

Note: an optional decorative threads kit for bobbin work samples will be available for \$2 paid to the teacher day of class. See supply list below.

SUPPLIES REQUIRED: (Be sure to purchase early)

Supplies Needed for Bobbin Work Samples:

- Sewing machine and Basic Sewing Kit, standard feet and accessory box, Bernina slide-on extension with guide or your seam guide that attaches to your feet (the one from your accessories box works great).
- For bobbin work you will need an EXTRA regular bobbin case (REQUIRED).
- For the book mark, you will use your extra bobbin case for bobbin work, embroidery bobbin case for decorative stitches, and regular bobbin case for assembling the bookmark. If you need to order a bobbin case, order early so you have this for class.
- Open Toe Embroidery Foot #20/20C (preferred) -or- Reverse Pattern Foot with Clear Sole #34/#34C (alternate)
- Fat quarter of muslin or light colored fabric for making bobbin work samples. Please bring a fabric you can write on. You will be able to refer to these samples in the future and you may wish to make notes on them.
- Fat quarter of a solid or near solid piece of fabric in a pretty color for bookmark.
- Several scraps of medium weight cut-away at least 4" x 8" in size (please, no Stabil-Stick, Hydro-Stick or Iron-on stabilizers).
- 505 Spray Baste.
- Bobbin work samples: various types of decorative threads will be provided for a small kit fee of \$2. You are also welcome to bring your own collection of decorative threads and silk ribbon for bobbin work samples. We will discuss thread in class and will be available for purchase. Possibilities:
 - YLI Candlelight
 - Yarns (must be thinner types like is used for knitting machines)
 - Glamour/Candlelight
 - Ribbon floss
 - Embroidery Floss (Cotton, Rayon, Metallic)
 - Perle Cotton
 - Pearl Crown Rayon
 - Designer 6
 - Silk Ribbon (up to 4 mm wide)
 - Oliver Twist—"Two of a Kind" heavy threads
 - Superior "Razzle Dazzle"
- Superior Mono-Poly or YLI Invisible thread -OR- neutral colored bobbin thread.
- Thread for the bookmark (**not** supplied as part of the kit fee)
 - Decorative thread to match bookmark fabric.
 - Coordinating thread for bookmark decorative stitches.
 - Regular sewing thread to match bookmark fabric
- Organ, Bernina or Schmitz 90/14 sharp needles H-J, H-Q, or Top Stitch/Cordonnet.
- Pen or pencil and notebook.

Please: items listed for class are required unless otherwise noted. Thanks!

For the bookmark sample, I used a combination of bobbin work and decorative stitches. I used YLI Candlelight thread for the bobbin work and YLI Variations for the decorative stitches. A coordinating Isacord would work in place of the YLI Variations.

- **Feet Required:** Open Toe Embroidery Foot #20/20C (preferred) or Reverse Pattern Foot with Clear Sole #34/#34C (alternate), EXTRA BOBBIN CASE REQUIRED.

Basic Sewing Supplies: Yes_X_ No___ *This includes: Good quality fabric scissors, small scissors or thread nips, straight pins, 6" seam gauge or ruler, seam ripper, fabric marker, assorted machine needles, pen and paper for notes, any other items you commonly use. Please call us with questions.*

Machine Requirements: *Your machine and embroidery unit should be in good working order. Please come with knowledge of operations suitable for the class content.*
