DESCRIPTION: Here's a fun and simple way to make flying geese. This is a great quilt to use up some scraps, or make a Christmas quilt or match a room for a fast wallhanging.

PREREQUISITE (If any):

SUPPLIES REQUIRED: (Be sure to purchase early)

Benartex flying geese foundation by the yard – 1 panel

Neutral colored thread for piecing

Rotary cutter, mat and rulers – have one longer ruler and one like the 6x6 square

FABRIC – You can make either the 2” or the 4” size geese. The sample is 2”.

100% Cotton (prewashed and iron – before class)

½ yd. for the background of the geese – White is in the sample

¼ yd. for the border and sashing – blue is in the sample

Yardage for geese will vary – if using scraps make sure the pieces are at least 2”x3” or larger

Yardage for backing and binding will vary depending on how many geese you make.

Feet Required: #37 or #57 patchwork foot

Basic Sewing Supplies: Yes_x__ No___ *This includes: Good quality fabric scissors, small scissors or thread nips, straight pins, 6” seam gauge or ruler, seam ripper, fabric marker, assorted machine needles, pen and paper for notes, any other items you commonly use. Please call us with questions.*
