Description: Learn how to use your embroidery module to stitch perfect quilting designs!

Prerequisite (if any): Machine/Embroidery Mastery Classes

Supplies Needed:

- Your favorite quilting design. Use one that comes pre-loaded on your machine, or chose any of the many quilting designs available from OESD. Bring several as you should have time to stitch them out. **Please have them pre-loaded on to your machine ready to stitch.**
- 1 yard of muslin fabric for practice piece. Any light solid colored fabric will work as well if you have stash fabric you would like to use.
- ½ yard of 100% cotton batting (Warm and Natural recommended). Scrap of batting will work – you will need at least a couple 20"x20" pieces
- Sewing machine in good working order
- Embroidery module and your selection of hoops – bring your large hoops!
- Templates for your hoops – we will use the templates (REQUIRED).
- Basic Sewing Kit.
- Acrylic table for the Embroidery Unit – bring this if you have it, we will use it.
- Machine quilting or Isocord thread in **contrasting** color to practice fabric so stitching will show.
- Bobbin thread for embroidery – OESD bobbin thread in white -or- Superior's The Bottom Line 60 wt in color to match top thread.
- Organ 90/14 sharp needles (required).
- HR5 Spray for basting.
- Water soluble marking pen
- Pen or pencil and notebook.

And if you haven't tried the new Hoop Springs yet – this is the class where they are worth their weight in gold! Bring them to class and I can show you how to put them on the hoop.

For this class you must have a quilting design pre-loaded on to your machine ready to stitch out. A design IS NOT provided in this class, but the required book does include designs you can use for this class.

Basic Sewing Supplies: Yes No

(This includes the following items: Good quality fabric scissors, small scissors or thread nips, straight pins, 6" seam gauge or ruler, seam ripper, fabric marker, assorted machine needles, pen and paper for notes, any other items you commonly use. Please call us with any questions.)

Machine Requirements: **Your machine and embroidery unit should be in good working order. Please come with knowledge of operation suitable for the class content. Sew from the Heart is happy to provide one of our classroom machines for your use. Please reserve your machine at registration and come 15-20 minutes ahead of class to give us time to get you set up and help you become familiar with the loaner machine.*
