CLASS DESCRIPTION: Log cabin blocks may look hard, but are as easy as pie! At the end of the series, you will have wonderful quilt to show off your newly learned talents. Judy Danz will walk you through each step of the quilting process, and as professional quilter and teacher, she has a wealth of experience to share.

PREREQUISITE (If any): Machine mastery classes.

SUPPLIES REQUIRED: (Be sure to purchase early)

- Book: ***Start Quilting with Alex Anderson*** (required for pattern).
- Sewing machine in good working order.
- Basic sewing kit - whatever you need for an enjoyable day of sewing
- $\frac{1}{4}$ " patchwork piecing foot for your machine make/model (required)
- Aurifil or Precensia 50wt sewing thread - color appropriate for piecing. I use mostly gray thread for piecing as reflects whatever color it is against. I keep on hand light gray, medium gray and dark gray and then match the value of the color rather than the actual color. The only exception is that if I have white or light cream fabric in my quilt, then I use a white or cream colored thread.
- *Sharp* sewing machine needles for Aurifil and Precensia thread: microtex 70/10 H-M, jeans 70/10 H-J, or quilting 75/11 H-Q. If you chose another brand of thread, then adjust needle size accordingly, size 80/12 is fairly universal for other brands of thread. Please do not bring universal or ball-point needles.
- 45mm medium-size rotary cutter with a new sharp blade (Olfa brand recommended)
- 24" or larger rotary cutting mat
- Rotary cutting rulers recommended: 7"x24", 4"x7" or the 7"x7" square-up ruler. The Nifty Notions brand of rulers are highly recommended
- Straight pins: slender glass-headed or flower-headed pins that slide easily into the fabric. If you have to push, then your pins are either too dull or too thick. .
- Seam ripper (Clover seam ripper recommended - it gets out ANY stitch).
- Pen or pencil and notebook
